Display of your own collection:



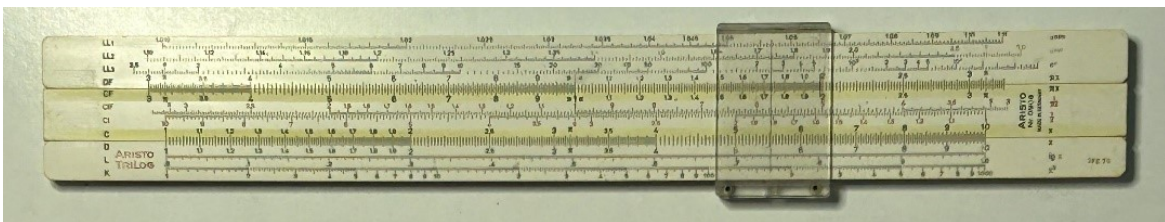
Some of the collectors display their collection, others store it in boxes. We can admire the efforts of everybody by showing it by 1 or 2 photos. Interesting aspects to discuss:
