

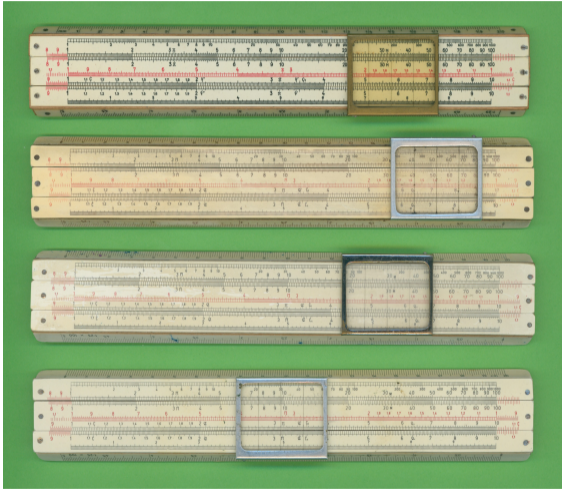

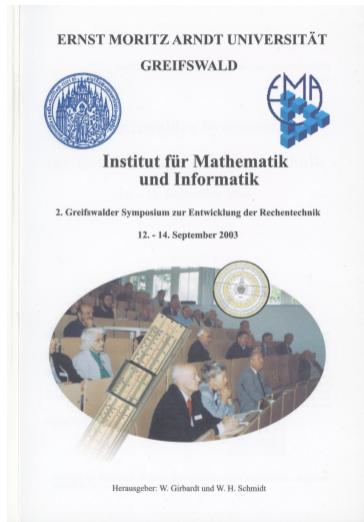

The manufacturer HH

- small company located at *Hohen Neuendorf*, a town neighbouring Berlin in the north; the place was in the former GDR
- company owned / run by A. A. *Höhler*
- so **HH** stands for *Höhler at Nohen Neuendorf*
- the HH Universum Rietz appears to be the only product they made; nothing known about drawing instruments as shown in the company logo (Burmester curves, straightedge / ruler, protractor)
- production started after WWII, probably ended mid to end of 1950s
- company size: Höhler and two employees
- next to nothing else know about HH
